Speaker: Matt Ackermann, CT Community Council Treasurer

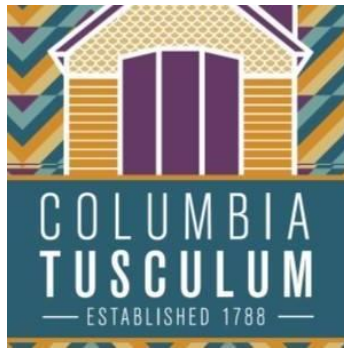
